Mexican Pesos are popular with collectors for their classic Mexican imagery showcasing the Winged Victory, which has been one of the most recognizable landmarks in Mexico City since 1910. These coins are large, at just over 1 oz, making them unique amongst other sovereign Gold coins.

The Mexican 50 Peso coin was first minted in 1921, and is often referred to as a "centenario" to honor Mexico's independence from Spain in 1821. These coins feature dual dates, which is not often seen on bullion coins.
