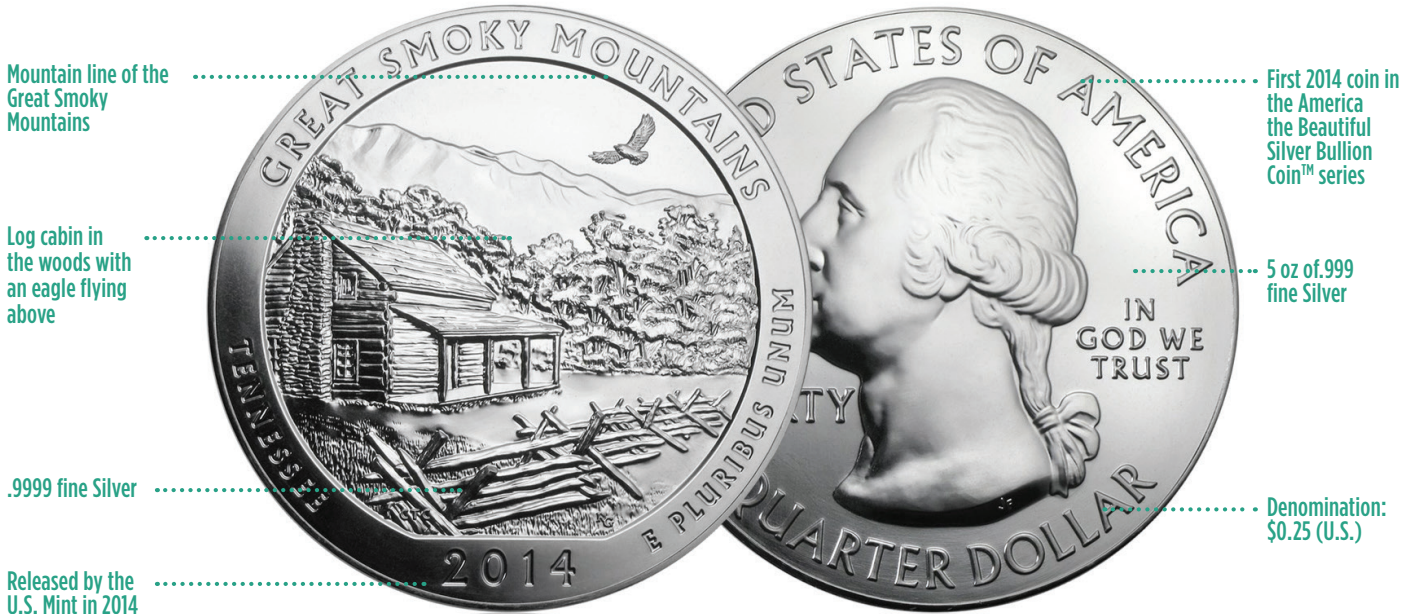


2014 5 oz Silver ATB Great Smoky Mountains National Park, TN



Since 2010, the United States has produced their popular America the Beautiful series, which honors national parks and monuments in each state. All coins in this series contain 5 oz of .999 fine Silver and feature unique, recognizable designs, providing appeal to investors and collectors alike. The Great Smoky Mountains Silver coin was the first release of 2014 and the 21st release overall in the series.

The Great Smoky Mountains are a sub range of the Appalachian Mountains formed between 200 and 400 million years ago, which cover 522,419 acres of land spanning Tennessee and North Carolina. The national park itself, established in 1934 and dedicated by President Franklin D. Roosevelt, sees more than 9 million visitors per year and is the most visited park in the United States and its territories.
