Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge covers nearly 16,000 acres along the eastern coast of Delaware. It was established on March 16, 1937 as a refuge for migratory birds along the Atlantic Flyway. Nearly 350 bird species have been recorded in the refuge, including the bald eagle and blue heron.

The U.S. Mint began its America the Beautiful series in 2010, releasing a unique design for a national park, forest or monument in each state and U.S. territory. The 5 oz Silver coins have gained popularity over the years for their designs and limited mintages. Their premiums have consistently increased year over year as well, adding further collectible appeal to these .999 fine Silver coins.
