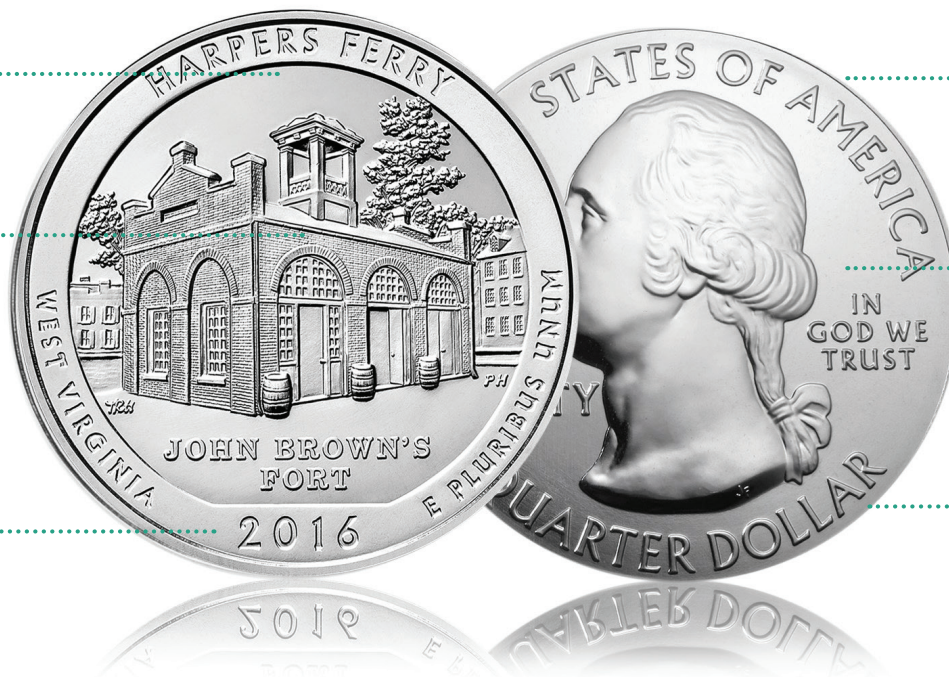


# 2016 5 oz Silver ATB Harpers Ferry National Historical Park, WV

Harpers Ferry is a small, historic town located where Maryland, Virginia and West Virginia meet. In 1859, abolitionist John Brown led a raid on the town armory in an attempt to arm and mobilize an abolitionist army in the heart of Old Dominion. This event is often thought of as a catalyst for the Civil War.

The U.S. Mint began its America the Beautiful series in 2010, releasing a unique design for a national park, forest or monument in each state and U.S. territory. The 5 oz Silver coins have gained popularity over the years for their designs and limited mintages. Their premiums have consistently increased year over year as well, adding further collectible appeal to these .999 fine Silver coins.
