Views of London are recognized around the world from film, television and artwork. But what do these sights look like to the locals? The new Landmarks of Britain series from The Royal Mint, who also bring you the Queen's Beasts series, seeks to show us, giving us unique angles instead of the classic straight-on imagery we so often see. The first bullion Landmarks of Britain release, with a mintage of just 50,000 coins, showcases the iconic Elizabeth Tower, which is home to Big Ben, the famous bell that has kept time for Londoners since 1859.

This APMEXclusive® Big Ben coin showcases collaborative imagery by Royal Mint designers Laura Clancy and Glyn Davies depicting Big Ben as a tourist might view the towering icon – from the street below. The tower is depicted as slightly obscured, by the environment and weather, providing a new perspective on a classic visual.
