

2017 5 oz Silver ATB Ellis Island National Monument, NJ



From 1892 until 1954, Ellis Island in Upper New York Bay was the first stop in America for more than 12 million immigrants. In fact, the wave of immigration during this time was so great, nearly 40% of Americans today can trace their ancestry through Ellis Island. In the 1990s, the park was able to expand from 3.3 to 27.5 acres, complete with an Ellis Island museum, adjacent to the Statue of Liberty on the New York side of the harbor.

The U.S. Mint began its America the Beautiful series in 2010, releasing a unique design for a national park, forest or monument in each state and U.S. territory. The 5 oz Silver coins have gained popularity over the years for their designs and limited mintages. Their premiums have consistently increased year over year as well, adding further collectible appeal to these .999 fine Silver coins.
