The design on the Dutch lion daalder, featuring a rampant lion and a knight, was first seen in 1617. These coins circulated into the mid-1800s, making this design extremely widespread throughout the Netherlands. The Royal Dutch Mint celebrated this design's 400th anniversary by releasing a .999 fine Silver coin.

In addition to the return of this timeless design, PCGS partnered with APMEX for their certified Dutch Silver Dollars, creating an exclusive label paying homage to the Netherlands by incorporating a windmill into a modern design of a tulip, two images closely associated with the Dutch.
